- 1. Bikeable Shoulder Primer
  - a. Is a state of the practice
    - i. Not a proposal for policy change or action
  - b. Suggested minor tweaks
    - i. Name of document
      - 1. Change to marked shoulders, or striped shoulder, for example
      - 2. Concerns over status of shoulders as travel lanes
    - ii. Update on feedback from other subcommittees
      - 1. They have reviewed document and changes have been incorporated
  - c. Result
    - i. Will look at Delaware documents to change some terminology and clarify status of shoulder as a travel lane
