1. What to tackle next from the wish list created at November retreat

- a. Vision Zero: if we focus on this, we need to take a serious look at what exactly Vision Zero is saying about enforcement, and how it affects minorities
 - i. Enforcement is about safety and right of way issues, not about broken tail light issues
 - ii. Vision Zero vs. Towards Zero Deaths
 - iii. Before we prioritize Vision Zero, we need to
 - 1. Clearly define/address equity issues related to enforcement and look at unintended consequences
 - 2. Be farther along in the process so that we can get to zero without watering down the initiative

Committee agreed to create a Vision Zero primer: What Vision Zero Is and What Vision Zero Isn't. Will be a joint project between this committee and the Education Committee. Will have someone from NYC present at the next BPAC meeting.

2. Discussion on Safe Passing legislation

- a. Update Safe Passing report to include what we've learned since it was published
- b. New Jersey is one of 12 states without a safe passing law
 - i. Formal recommendation to update 3 foot bill
- c. Pursue other bills around it
 - i. Dooring
 - ii. Stopping or standing in bike lanes
 - iii. Other initiatives states have passed to protect cyclists
- d. Recommend that NJ looks into these pieces of legislation

3. Other legislative updates

- a. "Coffee bill"
 - i. In committee this morning
 - ii. Would change law to cover anything you're doing outside the realm of operating your motor vehicle and it causes you to be distracted
