RESO 2018-177 Authorize the Adoption of a Complete Streets Policy for the Borough of Leonia

WHEREAS, the Borough of Leonia is committed to creating street corridors that safely accommodate all road users of all abilities; and,

WHEREAS, significant accomplishments have already been achieved by incorporating pedestrian safety and traffic calming measures when public streets are improved; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council supports this "complete streets" initiative and wishes to reinforce its commitment to creating a comprehensive, integrated, connected street network that safely accommodates all road users of all abilities and for all trips; and,

WHEREAS, that all public streets projects, both new construction and reconstruction (excluding maintenance) undertaken by the Borough of Leonia shall be designed and constructed as "complete streets" whenever feasible to do so in order to safely accommodate travel by pedestrians, bicyclist, public transit and motorized vehicles and their passengers, with special priority given to pedestrian safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Leonia, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, hereby adopts the "Complete Streets" policy as outlined in the resolution.
