RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Borough of Old Tappan to plan, design, build and maintain all roads to meet the needs of all users whenever practical, and

WHEREAS, this commitment applies to both new and retrofitted projects, including design, planning, construction, maintenance and operations for the entire right of way; and

WHEREAS, exceptions to this policy will be contingent upon the presence of specific safety concerns and set a clear procedure that requires high level approval prior to granting exceptions. The Borough will adhere to the Department of Transportation Policies as outlined in NJSA Title 27.

WHEREAS, this resolution requires the incorporation of the Complete Street Policy into the next reexamination, update, revision amendment or adoption of the Master Plan of the Borough of Old Tappan; and:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Old Tappan that we do hereby establish the Complete Streets Program in compliance with the Sustainable Jersey Program and the Department of Transportation,
