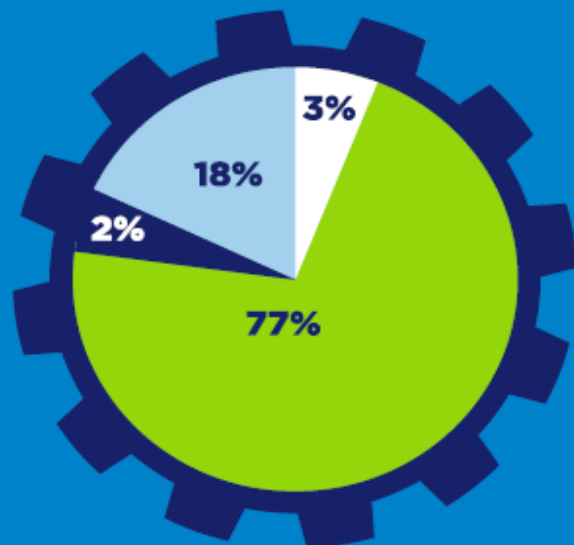

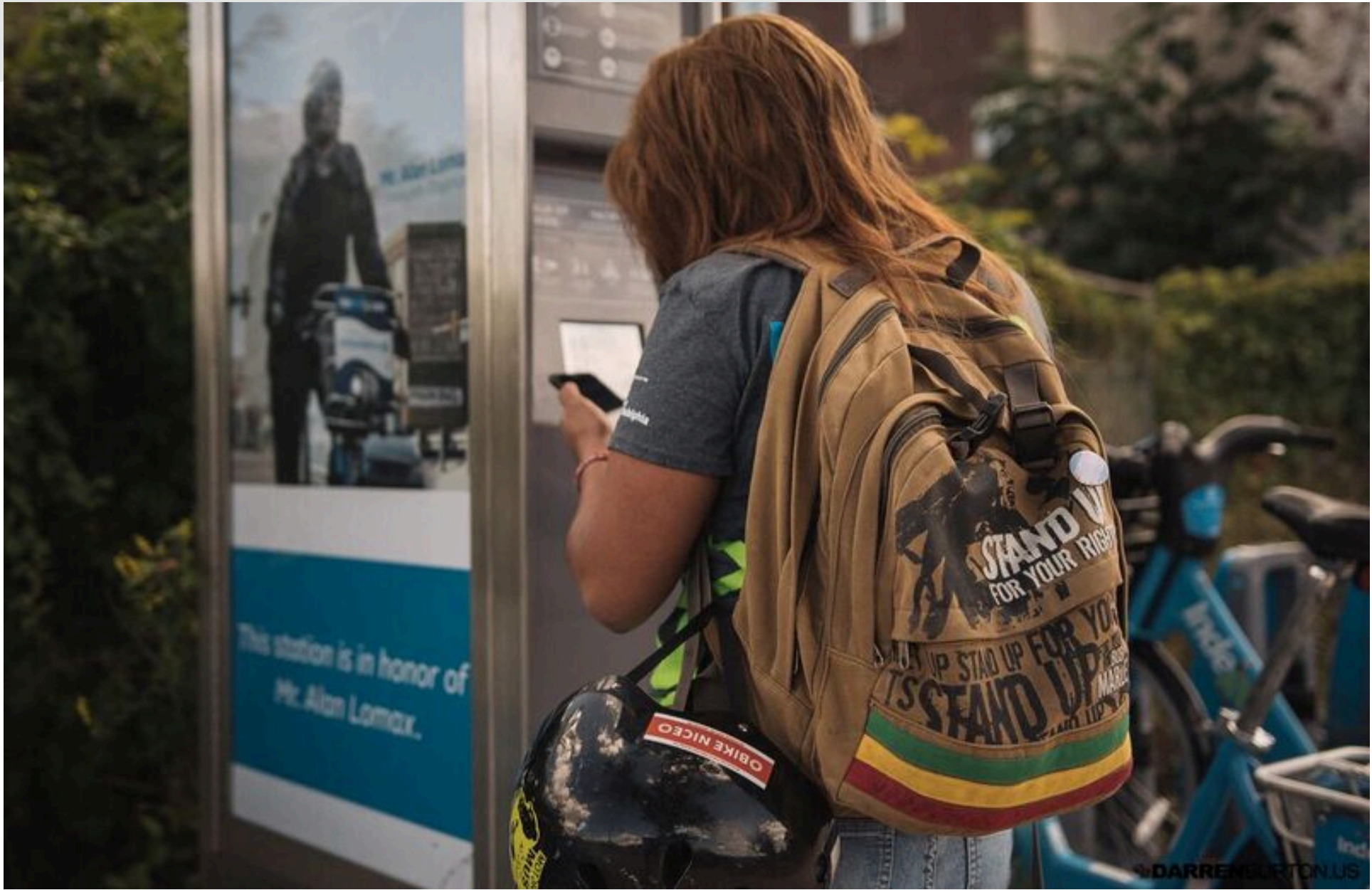

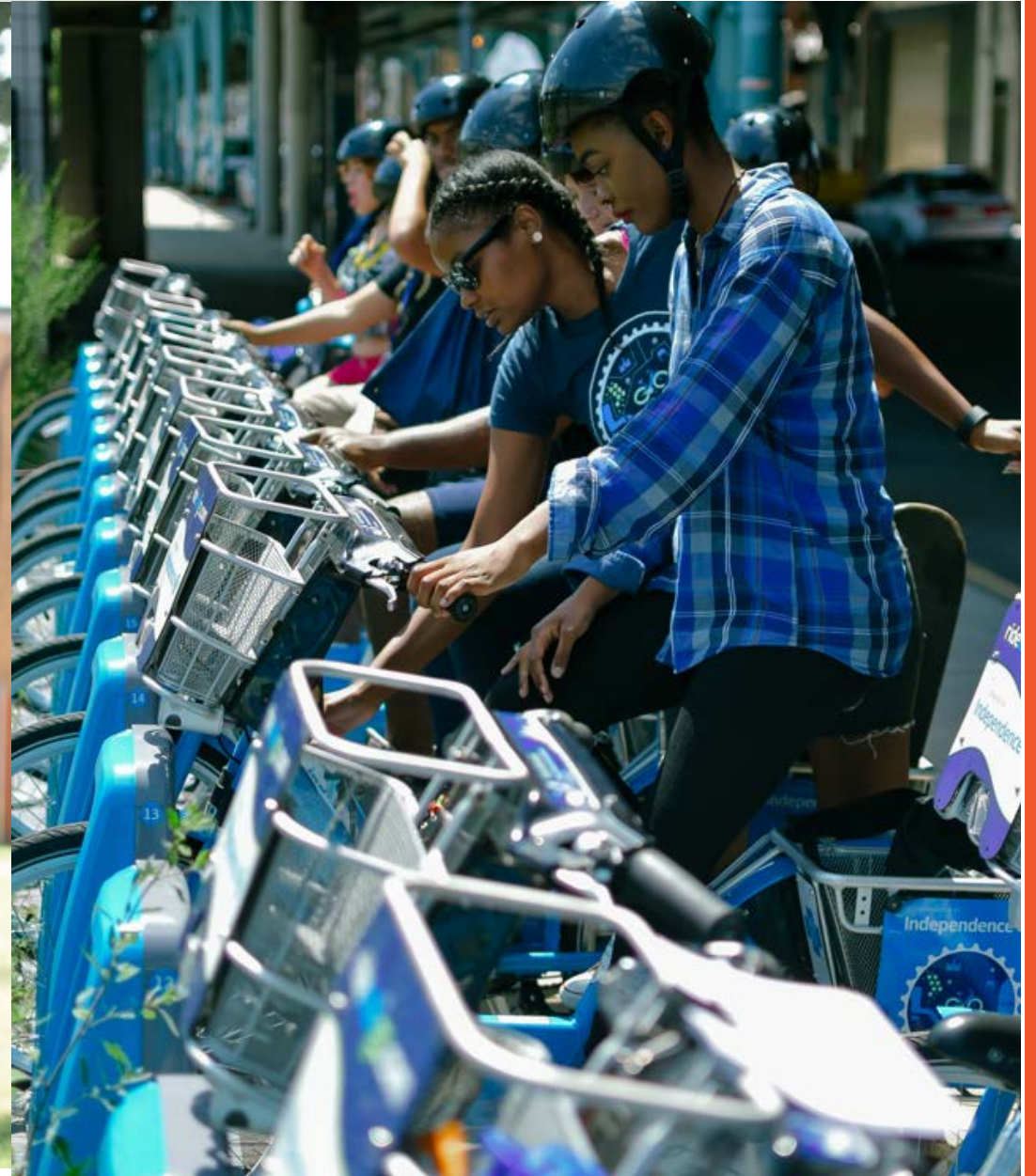

Indego30 Access Pass

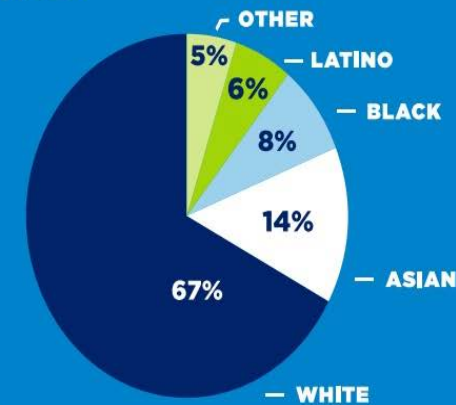

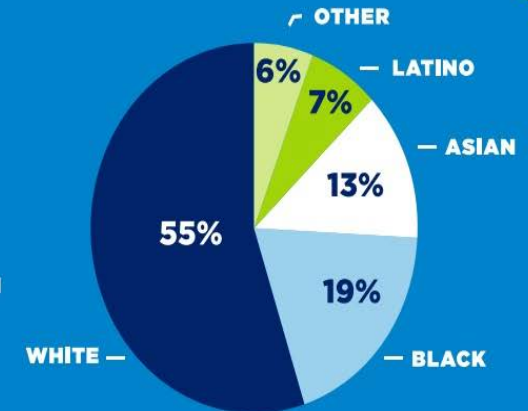
