




West Orange Walkable Community Workshop

- \$780,000


Audit recommendations included in the grant:

- Improved crosswalks
- Ped Xing signage
- ADA curb ramps
- Widened sidewalks at Washington/Columbia
- Landscaping



Seaside Heights Walkable Community Workshop

- Central Avenue Walkable
 Community Workshop
- Conducted August 2022
- Issues: pedestrian access and safety, long ped crossings, bicyclist safety, auto-oriented design, visitor parking, maintenance

















Potential road diet, increased pedestrian space, and simplified intersection at Franklin Avenue.

- Awarded FY 2023
- \$824,000

Audit recommendations included in the grant:


- Marked crosswalks
- Ped Xing signage
- Street trees
- Lighting
- Bike lanes



City of Passaic

- State Street & Hamilton
 Avenue Complete Streets
 Conceptualization
- 2022-2023 round
- Issues: bicycle accessibility









Passaic TA Set-Aside

- Hamilton Avenue and State Street Improvements Project
- Awarded FY 2023
- \$454,000

Concept recommendations included in the grant:

- Two-way parkingbuffered bikeway
- Concrete curb extensions
- Traffic signal relocation/upgrade



Other implementation examples

- **Eatontown** received a \$275,000 grant from NJDOT to advance a greenway concept.
- Manville received a \$48,000 RAISE grant for a study to investigate RR grade crossings.
- **Dunellen** requested striping recommendations for a repaving project, adjacent to the study area, scheduled to start during the study.
- Cranbury incorporated striping recommendations into their repaving.
