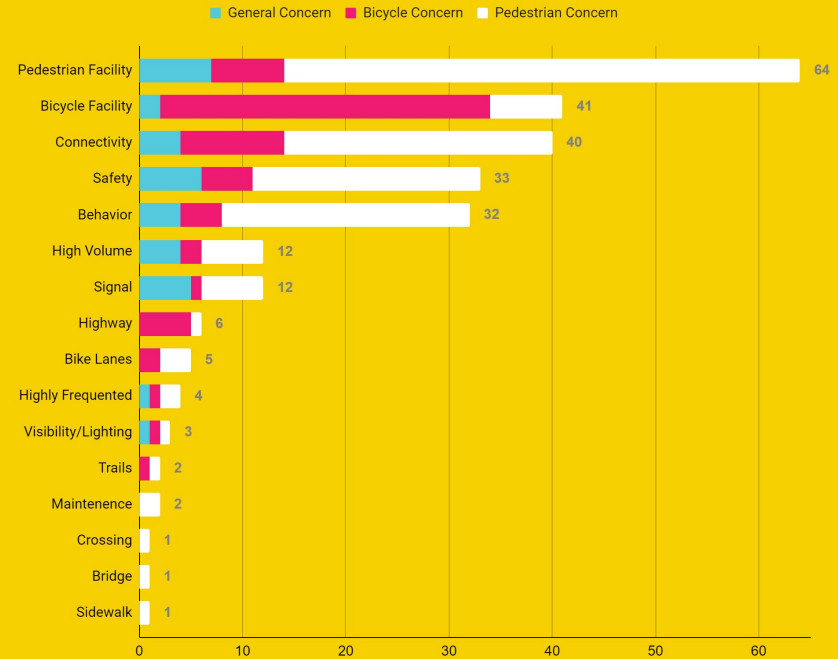

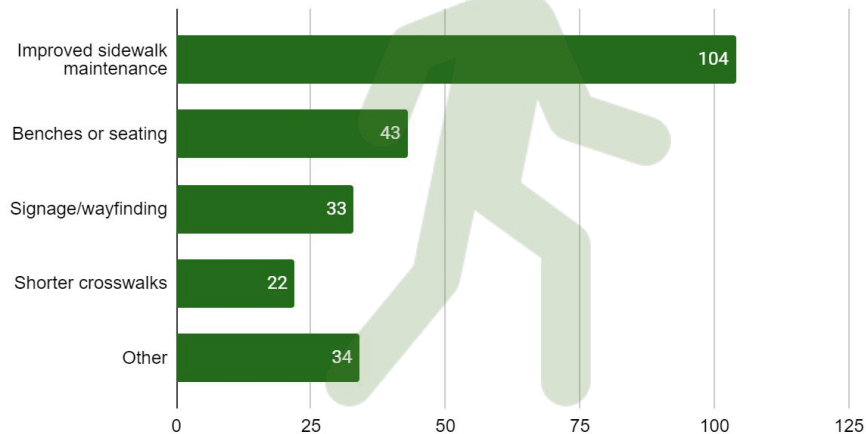

## Summary of Tags by User Selected Transportation Concern

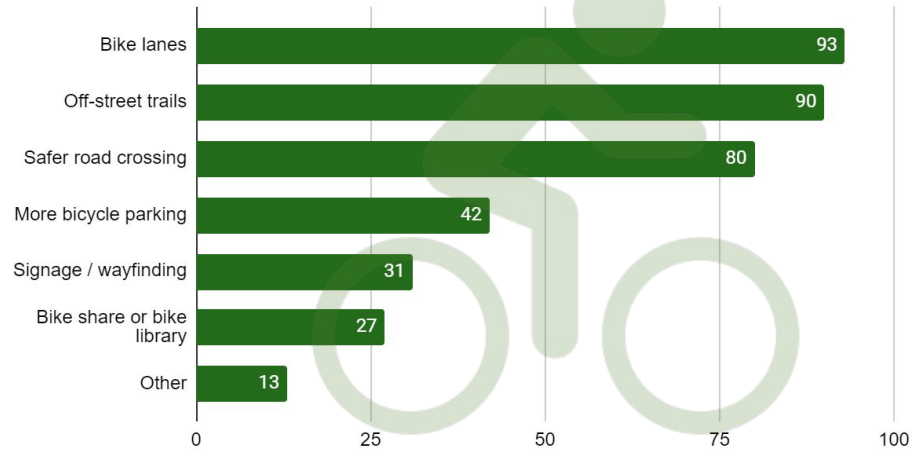

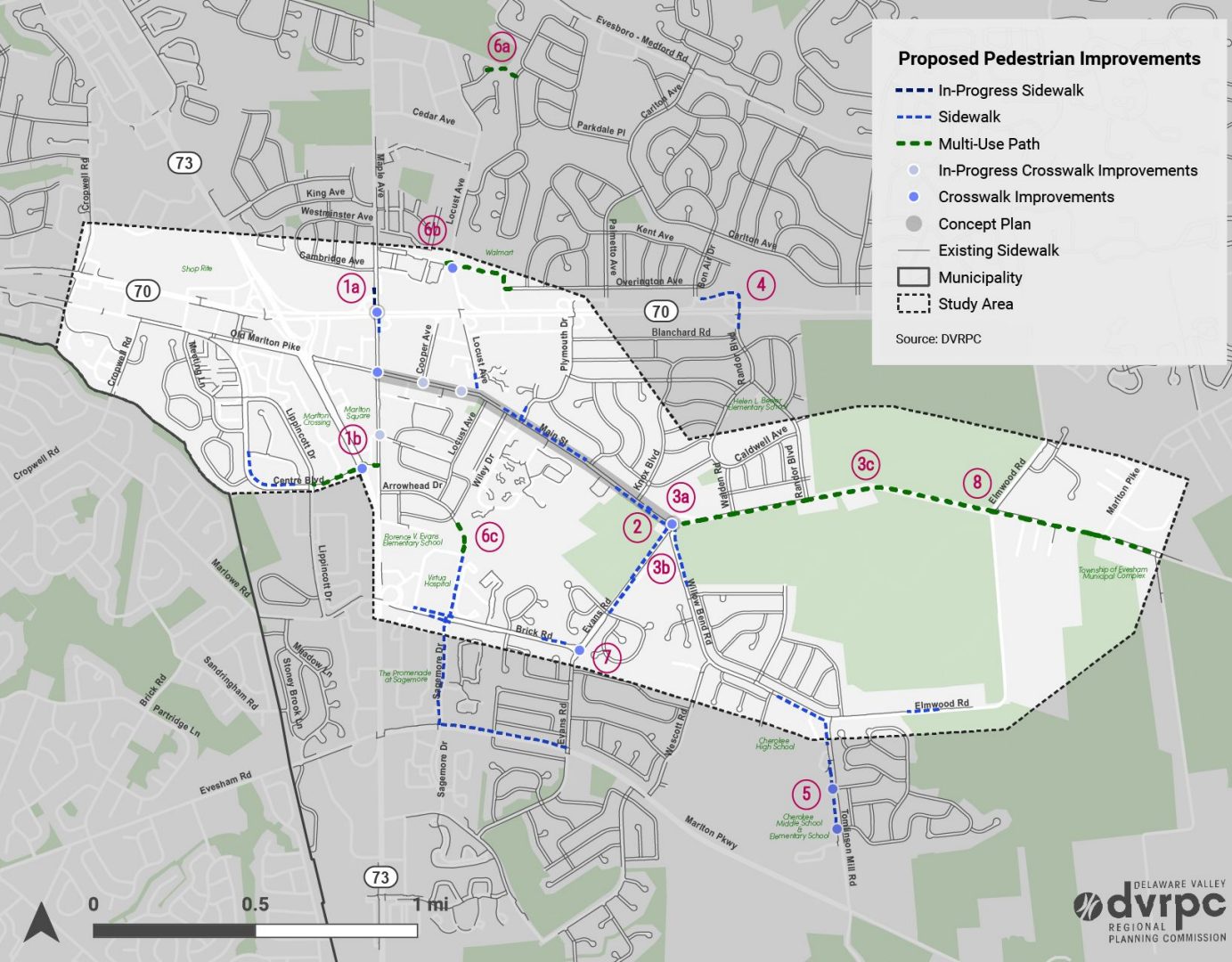








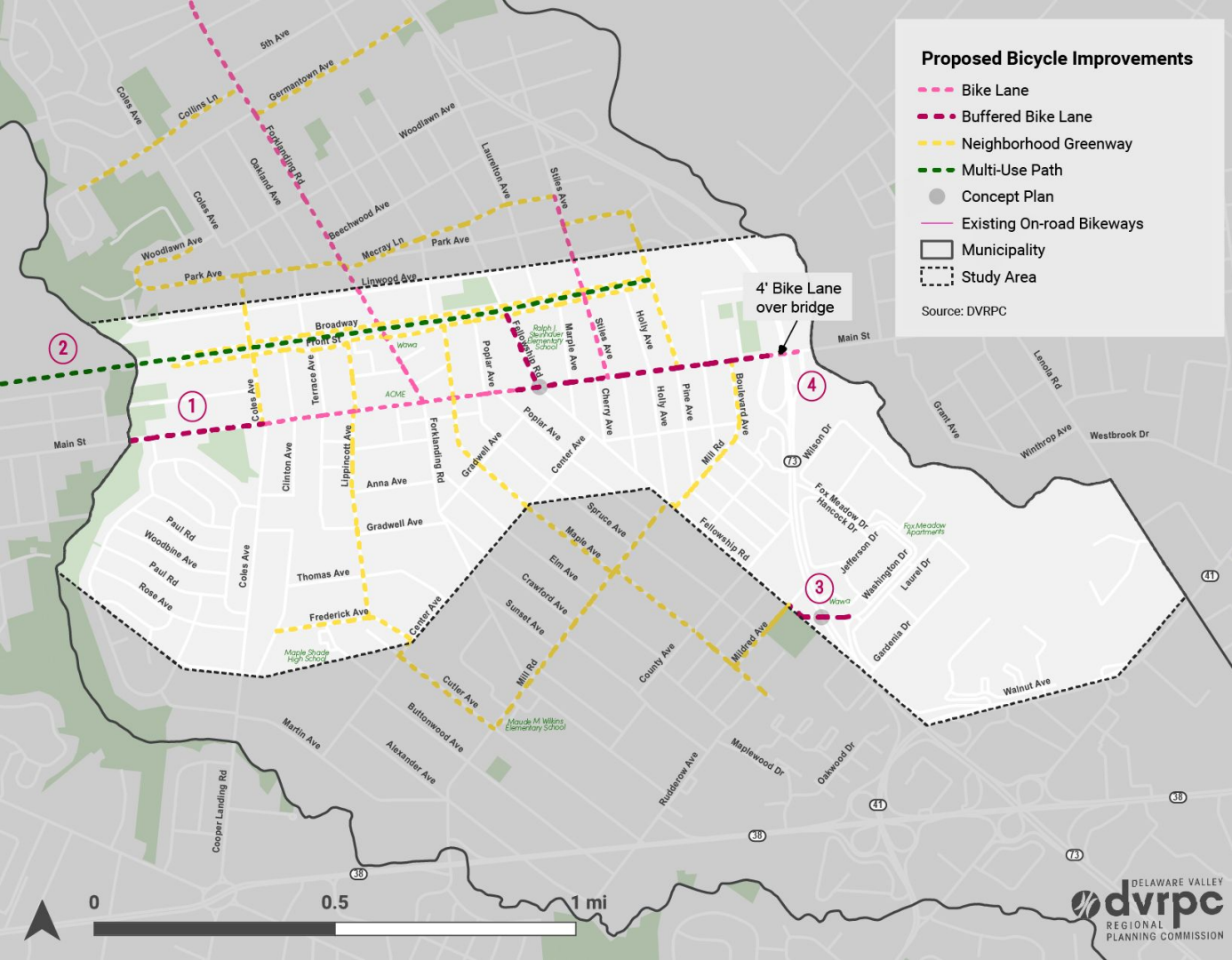




## Marlon Proposed Pedestrian Facilities

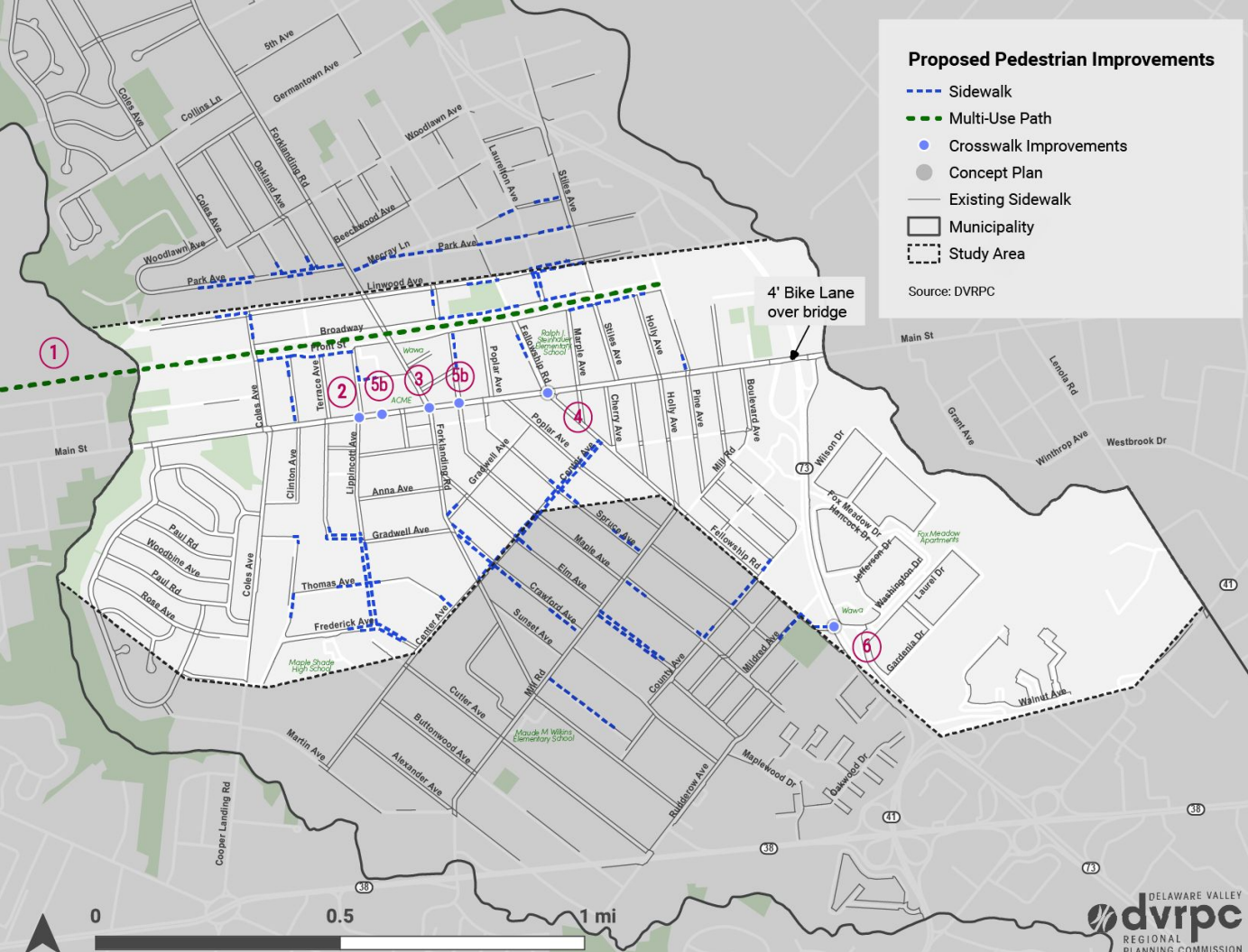
1. Route 70 and 73 crossing

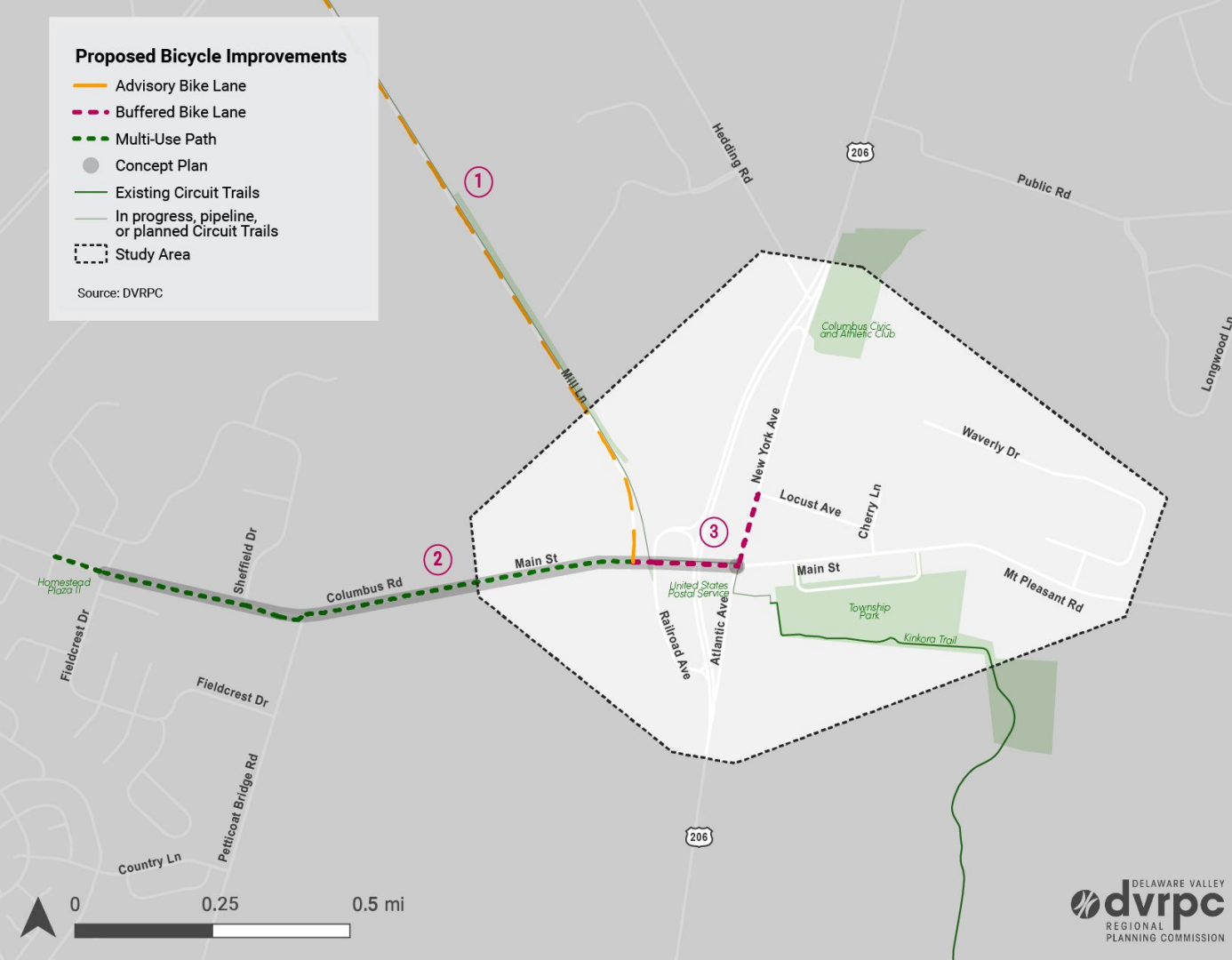
