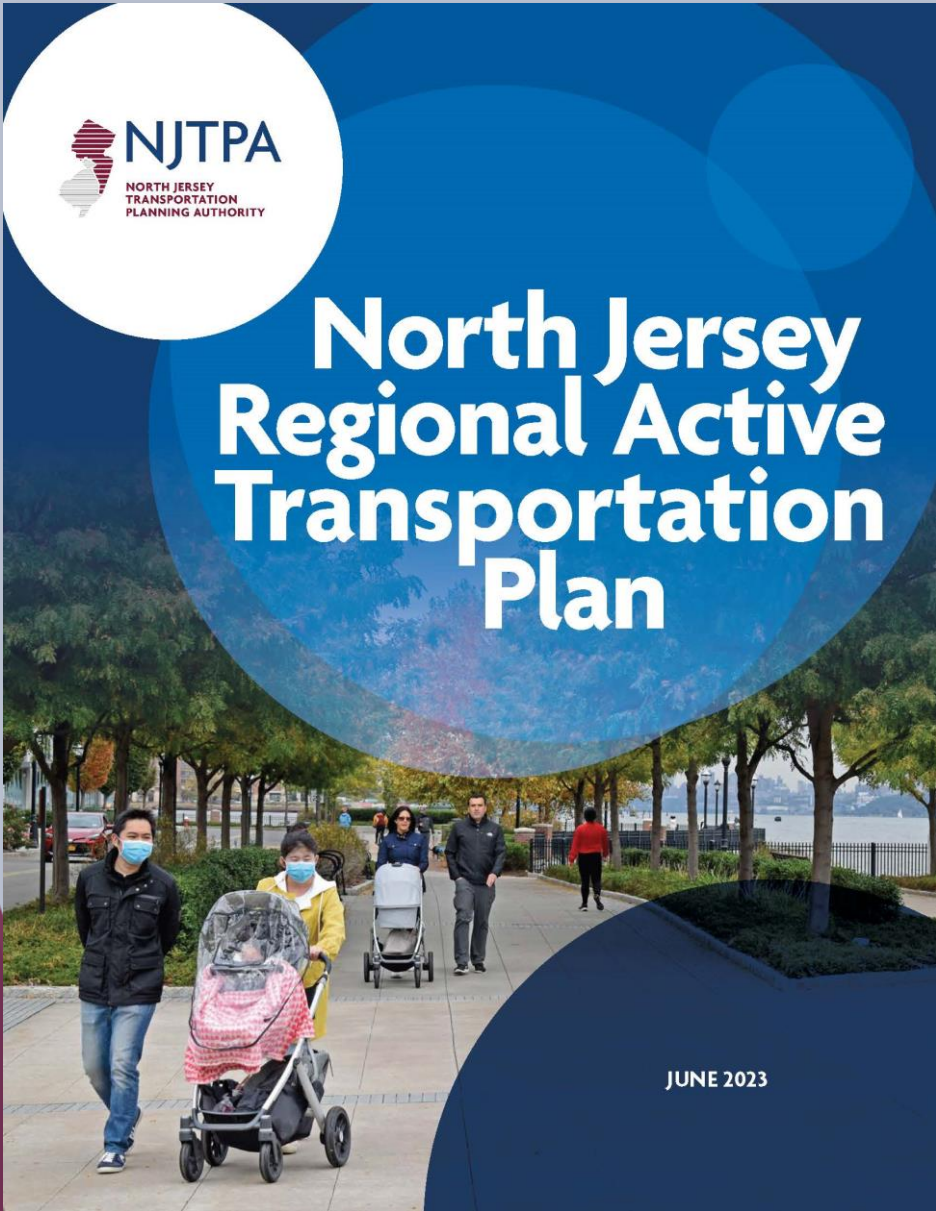
# Local Safety Actions Plans in the NJTPA Region

- Dozens of municipalities

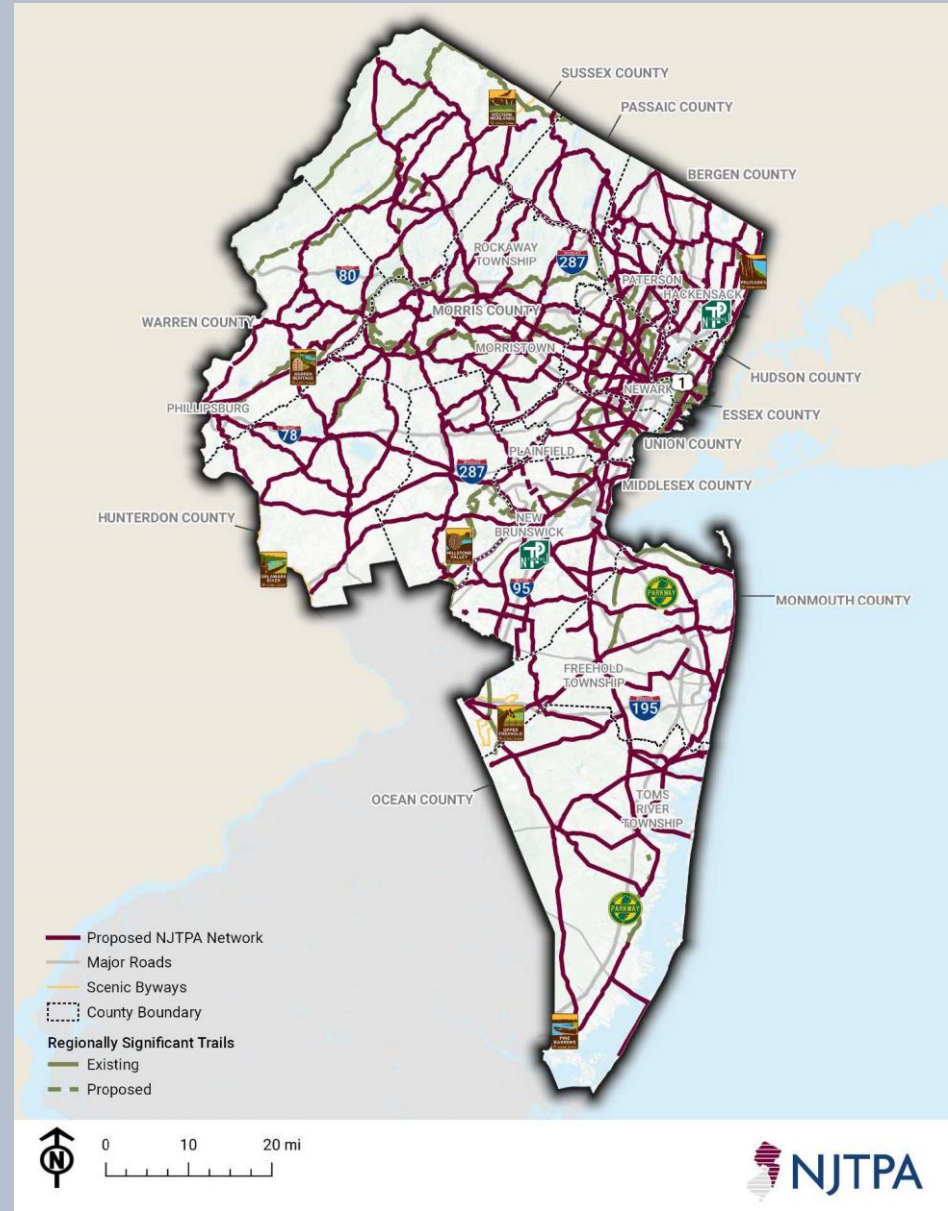




# North Jersey Regional Active Transportation Plan

### Planning for Emerging Centers

Planning for Emerging Centers supports the development of municipal plans and regulatory updates that respond to the demographic, land use, housing, accessibility, environmental, and economic changes taking place within the NJTPA region.

*Next Round: FY28*

### Vibrant Places

The Vibrant Communities Initiatives places targeted support to municipalities, counties, and community organizations in the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA) region through technical assistance, placemaking projects, information resources and workshops.

*Next Round: FY27*

### Transit Hub Planning

The Transit Hub Planning Program enables development of strategic plans to re-use, redevelop, or improve areas surrounding a bus, rail, light rail, or ferry station or stop in selected communities.

*Next Round: FY27*

### Complete Streets Technical Assistance

Complete Streets are designed to ensure the safe and adequate accommodation of all users of the transportation system, including pedestrians, bicyclists, public transportation users, children, older adults, individuals with disabilities, motorists, and freight vehicles.

*Next Round: Fall 28*

### Complete Streets Demonstration Library

Demonstration projects empower communities to test out road improvements to make their streets safer and more people-focused, utilizing short-term, low-cost, and scalable interventions to achieve long-term change related to street safety and public space.

*Open year-round*

# COMPLETE STREETS TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Technical assistance to municipalities to advance a Complete Streets initiative.

Provides knowledge, skills and resources to explore and develop Complete Streets-related solutions.

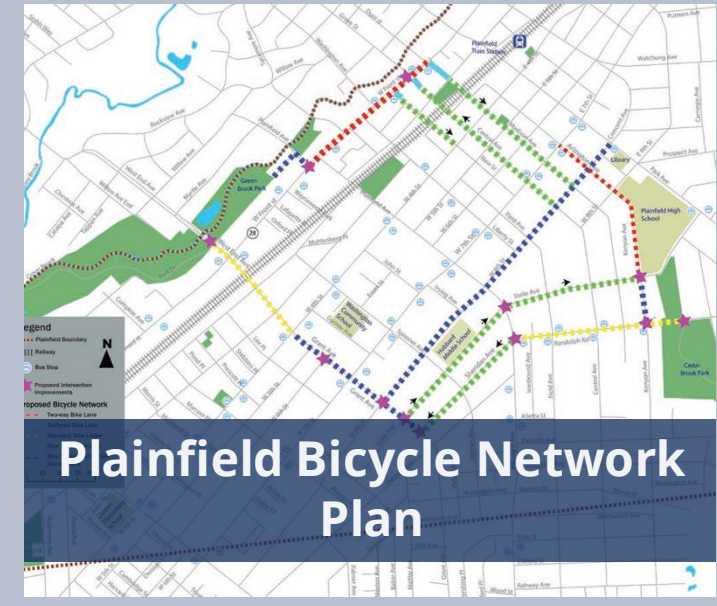

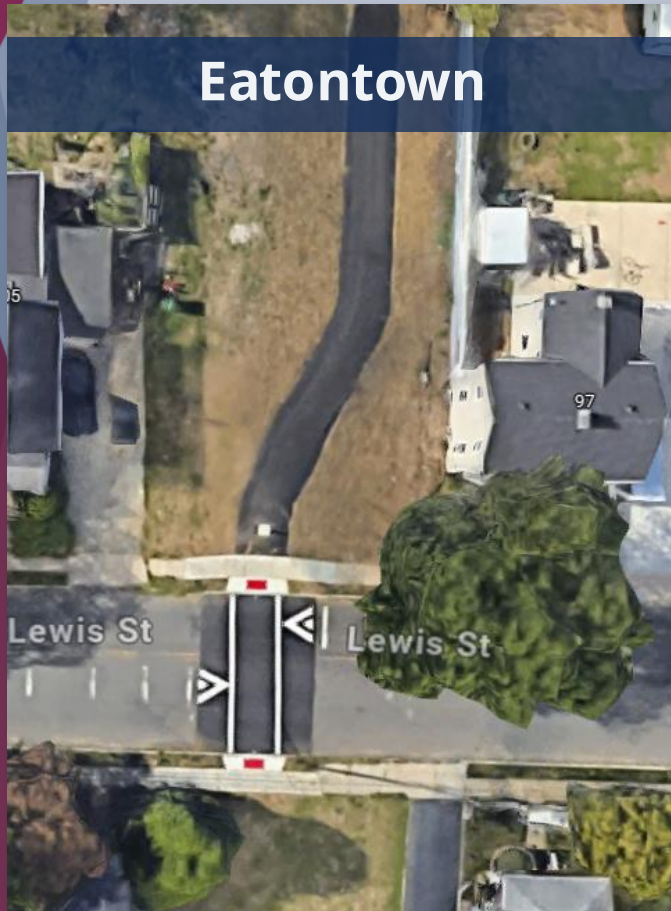

# Post-study Grants



- **Eatontown** - \$275,000 for a greenway
- **Manville** - \$48,000 for RR grade crossings
- **West Orange** - \$780,000 for a pedestrian crossing
- **Passaic** - \$454,000 for a bikeway
- **Seaside Heights** - \$824,000 for a road diet and bikeway
- **Belleville** - \$1.5m for parkway improvements
- **Belmar** - \$1.1m for a streetscaping project

# Complete Streets Demonstration Library

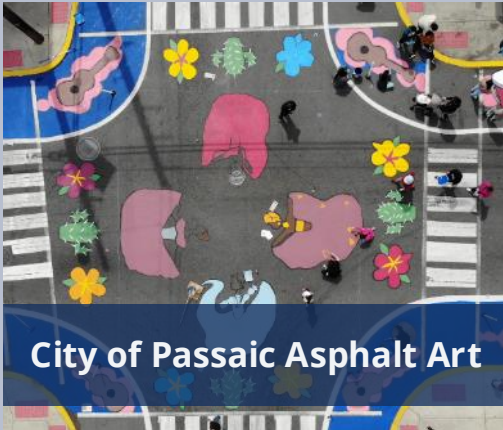
Program to assist communities test out Complete Streets and safety improvements to their roadways

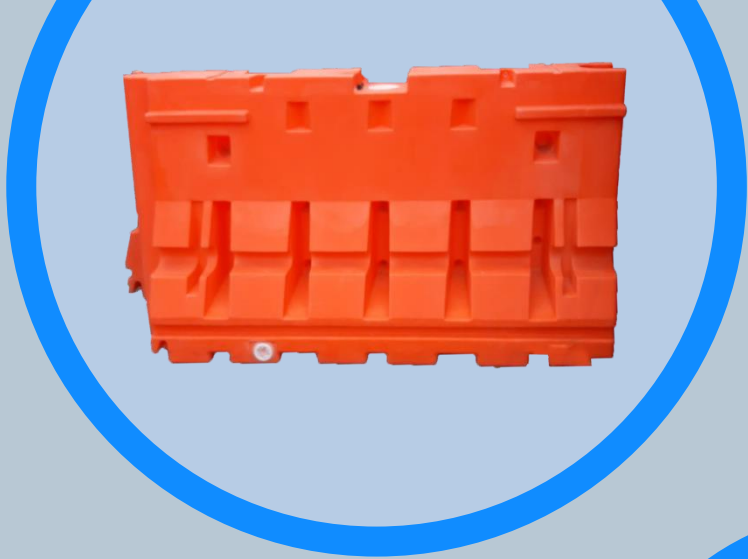
NJ Municipalities, Counties and TMAs are eligible to participate in the program

Projects can vary widely in size and duration, from a one-day parklet in a single parking stall to a multi-block bike lane lasting several months.

Materials are provided for **free** for communities to borrow. Pick-up/drop-off of materials is with Hudson TMA in Jersey City

# DEMONSTRATION TO QUICK-BUILD

**10/20/23:** Fatality occurred

**10/25/23:** Jersey City's Rapid Response Team conducted field visit

**April 2024:** The City installed a demonstration project with community volunteers along a 3-block stretch

**Aug. 2024:** On-call contractors installed semi-permanent quick-build improvements based on success of demo project
