









## 2025 TA Set Aside Solicitation

- Solicitation announcement anticipated Fall 2024
- Look for letters to the Mayor, Clerk, and Engineer (mailed copies) announcing program
- Use past guidance to be a basis to start planning your application
- Be on the lookout for updated guidance; letter mailed to LPA regarding solicitation
- One on One Meetings are mandatory and guidance on scheduling meeting will be provided

# Eligible Applicants

- Local Governments
- Regional Transportation Authorities
- Transit Agencies
- Natural resource or public land agencies
- Tribal Governments
- A metropolitan planning organization that serves an urbanized area with a population of 200,000 or fewer (MPOs representing areas over 200,000 population are not eligible)
- Nonprofits partnered with any eligible entity on an eligible project.






### What is an eligible project?

- Must relate to surface transportation
- Must be for a complete, identifiable and usable facility or activity (no partial projects that cannot usefully function on their own)
- Must meet the criteria for as least one out of 7 categories


